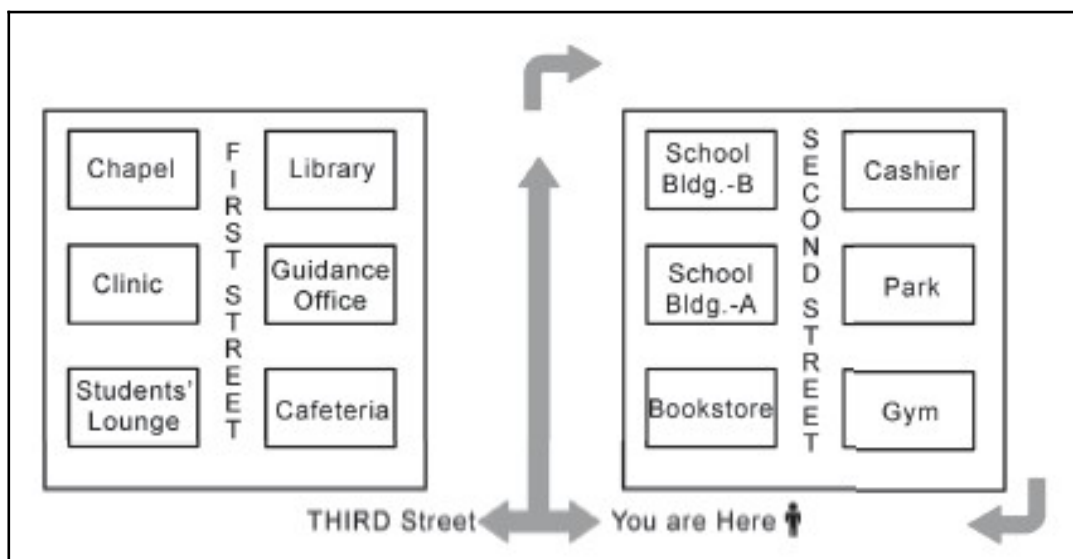
Learning Activity Sheet Articulating Details
