Purpose, Structure, and Features of Informational Texts That Show Sequence/Process

A. Read the following excerpts and identify the structure, purpose, and signal words present in the given informational texts. Use the given template as your guide in answering.

Paragraph A.

In order to create a homemade mosquito trap, you will need a cup of hot water, $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of sugar, a gram of yeast, and an empty 1.5-liter bottle. Cut the bottle in half around its middle. Next, place the sugar in the hot water and make sure that it is dissolved completely. Once done, place the mixture in the lower half of the bottle. You may then add the yeast to start the production of carbon monoxide that will attract the mosquitoes into your trap. Next, remove the bottle cap, flip the top of the bottle upside down, and push it into the bottom half of the bottle to create a funnel. Lastly, tape the two bottle pieces together. Empty the bottle and add a fresh mixture every 2 weeks or as needed.

Paragraph B.

When treating a small cut, make sure to wash your hands first with soap and water before getting into contact with the wound. Next, stop the bleeding by applying gentle pressure with a clean cloth or bandage. Once the bleeding stops, you may apply an antibiotic ointment to help in the quick healing of the wound. Cover the wound with a fresh bandage to keep it clean and protected from getting infected.
